WINEMAKER NOTES

This wine was made to delight the rosé drinkers who have expressed an interest in a sweeter version of what they already love. This Rosé exhibits the richness and wonderful fresh fruit aromas of our dry Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé, as well as the fragrant flowers typical of Muscat grapes. The extra sweetness allows us to balance the natural bitterness that Muscat often displays.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromas of raspberry and cherry mingle with hints of white floral. The silken mouthfeel is balanced with a touch of crisp acidity. Delicious flavors of dried strawberry, Bing cherry, and raspberry merge with Fuji apple and a touch of caramel with toasty notes in the background.
