WINEMAKER NOTES

The vision for Cache Creek Vineyard has always been to provide a classic Burgundian Chardonnay that takes advantage of the unique growing conditions available from this location. Meticulous care has been taken to use Burgundian Chardonnay clones, and to use classic yeast and techniques to provide this beautiful style. Even the barrels were made in Beaune, located in the heart of the Burgundy region in France.

TASTING NOTES

Aromatic layers fill the nose with ripe tropical fruit, toasty oak, and fresh lemon pie. The rich entry is balanced with crisp acidity and fine-grained oak. The round mouthfeel reveals an opulent blend of honeysuckle, ripe apple, and lemon zest along with traces of pineapple. Just a touch of coconut appears as the wine finishes and lingers on the palate.

Enjoy this lovely wine paired with creamy lemon chicken over fresh linguine, or mahi mahi with coconut rice and mango salsa.
