WINEMAKER NOTES

The vision for Cache Creek Vineyard has always been to provide a classic Burgundian Chardonnay that takes advantage of the unique growing conditions available from this location. Meticulous care has been taken to use Burgundian Chardonnay clones, and to use classic yeast and techniques to provide this beautiful style. Even the barrels were made in Beaune, located in the heart of the Burgundy region in France.

TASTING NOTES

Seductive aromatics of rich butterscotch and toasty oak weave through fresh cut pineapple. The luxurious entry fills the palate with opulent notes of caramel with traces of white floral. A rich blend of tropical fruit mixed with hints of lychee and lemon appears mid-palate, forming a bright beam of flavors. The wine is gently framed by toasted oak that lingers in the finish.

A terrific wine to pair with a shrimp Caesar salad, smoked pheasant and mushroom risotto, or a lemon tart for dessert.
