WINEMAKER NOTES

The vision for Cache Creek Vineyard has always been to provide a classic Burgundian Chardonnay that takes advantage of the unique growing conditions available from this location. Meticulous care has been taken to use Burgundian Chardonnay clones, and to use classic yeast and techniques to provide this beautiful style. Even the barrels were made in Beaune, located in the heart of the Burgundy region in France.

TASTING NOTES

From the first whiff to the lingering finish, this Chardonnay offers depth and complexity. Aromas of toasted oak mingle with traces of pineapple and mixed tropical fruit. A velvety entry introduces layers of the fruit found in the nose, along with lemon meringue pie, while toasty oak enhances the rich flavors. Definitely a white wine that red wine lovers will enjoy as well.

Lobster with drawn butter or fresh cracked crab are ideal pairings, but this wine can also stand up to a smoked turkey or sausage-stuffed quail.
