WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure "free-run" juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, which can be a perfect complement to your picnic or serve as an early evening aperitif.

The perfect warm weather sipper that even red wine lovers will enjoy.
