WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure “free-run” juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, which can be a perfect complement to your picnic or serve as an early evening aperitif.

The lovely salmon hue leads into aromas of vivid cherry and crisp juicy apple with just a touch of melon. Bright flavors bathe the palate with a refreshing wild berry essence mixed with hints of watermelon, cherry and vanilla. This dry rosé presents a lively mix of flavors and interesting depth. The perfect warm weather sipper that even red wine lovers will enjoy.

A chilled glass of this beauty is the ideal accompaniment for pepper encrusted seared ahi or chicken panzanella salad.
