WINEMAKER NOTES

This wine was made to delight the rosé drinkers who have expressed an interest in a sweeter version of what they already love. This Rosé exhibits the richness and wonderful fresh fruit aromas of our dry Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé, as well as the fragrant flowers typical of Muscat grapes. The extra sweetness allows us to balance the natural bitterness that Muscat often displays.

TASTING NOTES

Tantalizing aromatics of ripe Queen Anne cherry and honeydew mingle with subtle floral notes. A velvety creamy entry and mouthfeel caress the palate with juicy raspberry, cherry and melon. Traces of Honeycrisp apple, cranberry and honeysuckle join mid-palate, adding to the unexpected complexity of this wine. The luscious, layered flavors linger into the long finish.

This easy sipper can be enjoyed solo, but will also pair beautifully with appetizers or the main course. Try it with an artisan cheese platter, mahi mahi with coconut rice and mango salsa, or rosemary cherry balsamic roasted chicken.
