WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure “free-run” juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, which can be a perfect complement to your picnic or serve as an early evening aperitif.

TASTING NOTES

Inviting, fresh and vibrant aromatics of Rainier cherry and raspberry mingle with white floral and hints of lime zest. The creamy mouthfeel offers luscious flavors of dark cherry, strawberry, lychee, and pomegranate bathed with balanced acidity. Traces of mandarin orange and melon appear as the wine lingers on the palate.
