## WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure "free-run" juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, which can be a perfect complement to your picnic or serve as an early evening aperitif.

## **TASTING NOTES**

Perfumey aromatics of fresh cherry, Crenshaw melon and juicy strawberry are laced with the enticing scent of a spring orchard in bloom. A smooth, richly textured entry offers delicious flavors of Maraschino cherry, pear and watermelon. As the wine flows into the long finish, traces of raspberry join the layers of cherry that expand and linger.

A perfect wine to enjoy with grilled cedar-planked salmon, or green chile chicken enchiladas.
