WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure “free-run” juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, similar in style to French Bandol region rosés. A perfect complement to a picnic, meal or serve as an early evening aperitif.

TASTING NOTES

Enchanting aromas offer sweet ripe cherry and dark plum laced with a creamy essence. The palate follows suit with delicious flavors of wild blackberry and black plum bathed in balanced mouthwatering acidity. Hints of fresh strawberry pie appear as the wine persists into a long finish.

This is the perfect picnic wine, or enjoy it with a backyard barbecue. Versatile and delicious, try pairing with a charcuterie board, favorite summer pasta salad, or spicy barbecue ribs.
