WINEMAKER NOTES

The Sweet Rosé is only slightly sweet when compared to our dry Rosé. Like the dry Rosé, it's made from pure "free run" juice that was drawn off the skins after a bit longer time than the "dry" version. The juice is then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the watermelon like aromas and flavors from the Cabernet. The resulting wine is rich with a lingering, almost sweet finish.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromatics of freshly sliced watermelon and Queen Anne cherry fuse with hints of white floral and savory herbs. The juicy entry exposes luscious watermelon and ripe red cherry bathed in a creamy, round texture. The rich flavors are nicely balanced with gentle acidity, adding to the wine's depth.

This perfect poolside wine will also pair with grilled coconut curry chicken over basmati rice, or country French pork with cherries and roasted fingerling potatoes.
