WINEMAKER NOTES

This dry Rosé, made the classic Provence-style, exhibits the clear expression of quality Cabernet juice grown in Cache Creek Vineyards. It is pure “free-run” juice that was drawn off the skins early, and then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the watermelon like aromas and flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon. The result is a refreshing and crisp wine, which can be a perfect complement to your picnic or serve as an early evening aperitif.

TASTING NOTES

The tantalizing aromas of fresh strawberry and cherry mingle with a creamy essence that draws you to your first sip—and then you’re hooked. The velvety smooth mouthfeel fills the senses with a pure juicy ripened strawberry essence fused with Rainier cherry and just a touch of Honeycrisp apple. Bright acidity adds to the wine’s appeal as it carries the delicious flavors into a long finish.

This ideal sipping wine would pair perfectly with an artisan cheese platter, or seared ahi served with a pecan, strawberry, and spinach salad tossed with a berry balsamic.
